## Directions to Hot Liquid

### Office & Training Centre

Upon entering Shamrock Quay Marina (free parking) you will find our Training Centre past the first car park, just after the Yellow Welly and Blue Rock house on the left hand side.

### How to Find Shamrock Quay Marina

#### By Rail

Arriving at Southampton Central Station Shamrock Quay is a short taxi ride away - Radio Taxis – 023 8066 6666

#### By Air

Arriving at Southampton Parkway Airport Shamrock Quay is a taxi ride away

#### By Road

**M27 Eastbound** – exit Junction 3 onto the M271. Follow signs to the 'Waterfront'. When you reach the traffic lights at Ocean Village, carry straight on and follow the road around until you come to a T-junction, turn right and about 0.5 miles up that road you will pass Southampton Football Club. Bear right at the roundabout and after a further 0.5 miles opposite Tile World you will see a signpost for Shamrock Quay. Turn right and the marina is 120 yards along on the right-hand side.

**M3 Southbound** – exit Junction 14 onto the A33. Follow the signs to the 'Docks' and 'Old Waterfront' and then as above.

**M27 Westbound** – exit Junction 7 onto the A334. Follow the signs to Southampton City Centre. At the traffic lights after the bridge over the River Itchen, turn left into Prince's Street (the Meridian TV Studios are on the right-hand side of the bridge). Continue along this road for about 0.5 miles and opposite Tile World you will see a signpost for Shamrock Quay. Turn left and the marina is 120 yards along on the right-hand side.
